Galatians 5:1-6:18

A Working Translation from A Journey through the Acts and Epistles

Galatians 5:

- ¹ Christ freed us with freedom. Therefore, stand fast and do not be entangled again with a voke of bondage.
- ² Behold, I, Paul, say to you that if you would become circumcised, *then* Christ will profit you nothing.
- ³ I testify again to every person who becomes circumcised that he is obliged to do the whole law.
- ⁴ You who *seek to* be justified by law have been made inactive from Christ. You have drifted away from the grace.
- ⁵ Moreover, we through the spirit patiently wait for the hope of justice by believing,
- ⁶ for in Christ Jesus, neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any force, but believing energized by love.
- ⁷ You were running well. Who hindered you so that you did not obey the truth?
- ⁸ This persuasion *is* not from Him Who called you.
- ⁹ A little leaven leavens the whole lump of dough.
- ¹⁰ I have confidence in the Lord regarding you that you will not think otherwise, and he who agitates you will bear his judgment, whoever he may be.
- ¹¹ Brothers, if it is understood that I am still heralding circumcision (so why am I still being persecuted?), then the stumbling block of the cross has been made inactive.
- ¹² If only those who disturb you up would emasculate themselves!
- ¹³ Certainly you were called to freedom, brothers. Only *do* not *use* the freedom for an opportunity of the flesh, but rather by love serve one another.
- ¹⁴ In fact, the whole law has been fulfilled in one word, *even* in this: Leviticus 19:18:
- "You will love your neighbor as yourself."
- ¹⁵ However, if you bite and devour one another, watch that you be not consumed by one another.

- ¹⁶ Now I say, walk by means of the spirit, and you will in no way carry out the craving of the flesh.
- ¹⁷ In fact, the flesh craves against the spirit, and the spirit against the flesh, for these *things* are opposed to each other with the result that you do not do what you desire *to do*.
- ¹⁸ However, if you are being led by means of the spirit, *then* you are not under the law.
- ¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are fornication, uncleanness, unbridled lust,
- ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hostilities, strife, jealousy, hot tempers, factious strifes, divisions, sects,
- ²¹ envy, {+ murders} drunkenness, carousing, and such *things* like these. I say to you ahead of time, even as I said previously, that they who practice such *things* will not inherit the kingdom of God.
- ²² However, the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, believing,
- ²³ meekness, self-control. Against such *things* there is no law.
- ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ have *already* crucified the flesh with the sufferings and the cravings.
- ²⁵ Since we are alive by means of the spirit, *then* by means of the spirit let us also walk with orderly conduct.
- ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

Galatians 6:

- ¹ Brothers, even if a person is overtaken by some trespass, *then* you *who are* spiritual, restore such *a person* in a spirit of meekness, keeping a watchful eye on yourself so that you also are not tempted.
- ² Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
- ³ Certainly, if anyone seems to be something *of reputation* when he is nothing, *then* he deceives himself.
- ⁴ Let each prove his own work, and then will he have [grounds for] boasting in himself alone and not in someone else.
- ⁵ In fact, each will bear his own load.
- 6 Let him who is being instructed in the Word [of God] share with him who instructs him in all good things.
- ⁷ Do not be misled. God is not *to be* sneered at. In fact, whatever a person sows, that will he also harvest.
- ⁸ for he who sows to his own flesh will harvest corruption from the flesh, but he who sows to the spirit will harvest eternal life from the Spirit.

11 Look at how large the letters are with which I am writing to you by my own hand.

- ¹² As many as desire to make an impressionable show in the flesh, they compel you to be circumcised, only to avoid being persecuted for the cross of Christ.
- ¹³ In fact, those who are circumcised do not even keep the law themselves, but they want you to be circumcised so that they may boast in the flesh that belongs to you.
- ¹⁴ Be it far from me to boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me and I to the world.
- ¹⁵ Furthermore, {+ in Christ Jesus} neither is circumcision anything nor uncircumcision, but a new creation,
- ¹⁶ and as many as will walk with orderly conduct by this standard [*measuring rod*], peace and mercy *be* upon them, even upon the Israel of God.
- ¹⁷ Hereafter, let no one cause me *such* hard labor, for I am bearing the brands of Jesus in my body.
- ¹⁸ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers. Amen.

⁹ Let us not be discouraged as we do the good, for in due season we shall harvest, *provided* we do not become exhausted.

¹⁰ Therefore, as we have the season, let us work the good toward all, especially toward *those who are* of the household of the [*right way of*] believing.
