## **Essentials for Life**

Matthew 4:4:

But he [Jesus] answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

Matthew 6:31-33:

Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?

(For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

John 3:3:

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again [from above], he cannot see the kingdom of God.

# Wisdom, Strength, and Courage

#### Deuteronomy 6:4-9, 13-14.

6:4: LORD = YHWH (Yahweh or Jehovah); God = elohim.

3:24: Lord = Adonai (lord); GOD = YHWH.

6:4 (Darby): Hear, Israel: Jehovah our God is one Jehovah;

6:4 (YLT): 'Hear, O Israel, Jehovah our God is one Jehovah;

6:4 (NJB): 'Listen, Israel: Yahweh our God is the one, the only Yahweh.

They were to write God's Word everywhere, especially in their hearts. He was the one God they were to serve.

#### Deuteronomy 8:2-4.

Without God's Word, the children of Israel would not have been able to survive in the wilderness.

#### Deuteronomy 17:14, 18, 19.

Kings were to write a copy of the law, and they were to read it daily.

#### Deuteronomy 27:1-8.

Moses instructed the children of Israel to build an altar at Ebal and to write on it all the words of the law very plainly.

#### Joshua 8:30-35.

Joshua built the altar at Ebal and wrote a copy of the law of Moses on the altar in the presence of the children of Israel. Afterward, he read all the words of the law to them.

#### Deuteronomy 31:1-13.

Wisdom: to do according to God's Word.

The people were to be strong and of a good courage.

Joshua was to be strong and of a good courage

#### Joshua 1:1-9.

Be strong and very courageous that you may observe to do according to all the law, which was God's Word to Israel.

#### John 7:37-39:

In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

### To the Church

On the Day of Pentecost after Jesus had been glorified, people were born of spirit for the first time. They were filled with holy spirit and manifested it by speaking in tongues.

#### Romans 7:4-6:

Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become dead to the law by the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another, *even* to him who is raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.

But now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of spirit, and not *in* the oldness of the letter.

Romans 10:4: For Christ *is* the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.

#### Ephesians 1:12-23.

The spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him.

#### Ephesians 2:1-10.

Made alive with Christ. Raised with Christ. Seated in the heavenly realm in Christ Jesus. We are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus.

#### Ephesians 6:10-20.

Ephesians 6:10 (WT): Henceforth, be strong in the lord and in the strength of his ability.

Know the wisdom of God as given to the Church.

Be strong in the lord.

Be courageous and speak the Word of God boldly, confidently, and freely.
