God's Word of Truth

John 17:1, 6, 14-20.

God's Word is Truth. It sets people apart from the common lot of people. Building God's Word of Truth in your heart and life is what separates you from the world so that you can walk with our heavenly Father as Jesus Christ did.

Romans 1:18-25.

Verse 18. Hold: Greek: $katech\bar{o} = to$ hold fast or to hold down (depending on the context). To hold down is to detain, to restrain, to suppress.

Verse 25. They changed the Truth of God into a lie. They made images of creatures to serve in place of the One Who Created them.

<u>Truth – Truth plus – part Truth – a bit of Truth –- Lies</u>

Genesis 3:1-6.

Luke 4:1-13.

Stones to bread. Eat of every tree?

Power over all kingdoms. Be as God?

Cast yourself down. Not surely die?

II Corinthians 11:3 and 4.

Verse 3. Simplicity: Greek: $haplot\bar{e}s =$ simplicity, singleness, integrity (as opposed to duplicity or double standards). After this word, some critical Greek texts add words meaning "and the purity."

II Corinthians 11: 3 and 4 (WT):

However, I fear lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your thinking processes might be corrupted from the integrity and the purity that *is* in Christ.

In fact, if someone comes and heralds another Jesus whom we did not herald, or *if* you receive a different spirit that you did not receive *previously* or a different gospel that you did not accept *previously*, *then* you put up with it *all too* well.
